Transitional provisions (Y/N)	No. The control applies to all applications subject to the policy from the gazettal date.
How it may affect you	<p>Amendment C157 introduces three new local planning policies into the Moreland Planning Scheme for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Licensed Premises and Entertainment Venues (Clause 22.09) • Gaming (Clause 22.10), and • Student Accommodation (Clause 22.11). <p>The amendment seeks to provide clear guidance for Council, the community, business operators and the development industry, when assessing planning permit applications, as to the appropriate locations, operating hours and internal and off-site amenity impacts of these uses, within the City of Moreland.</p>
Where does it apply?	All land within the City of Moreland
What kinds of applications are likely to be affected by this amendment?	All applications for licensed premises and entertainment venues, gaming machines and student accommodation subject to a permit under the Moreland Planning Scheme.
