

FLEMING PARK | Open Space Upgrade 2017 | Revised Concept

Council has allocated funds in this financial year to commence refurbishment of park infrastructure at Fleming Park. Following consultation with the local community, the concept has been revised, realigning the shared path to creating space for a combined new play and picnic area, to reduce conflict between park users and cyclists passing through. Redundant light poles, the existing toilet and shelter will be removed to make way for the new play and picnic area, which includes a new shelter and single cubical, accessible toilet.

It is planned that works will commence late April and be complete by the end of June.

Planning for development of the Fleming Park Community Centre is underway. Further consultation will occur regarding the existing buildings, current and future needs at a later date.
