*Concession applies to residential parking permits for all holders of Centrelink cards (e.g. Pensioner, Health Care Card) and Department of Veterans Affairs cards.
*To receive the reduced fee, a copy of a current concession card, in the applicant's name, must be provided with the application.

Identification Checklist

All applications require one (1) piece of residential identification.

Resident, Visitor and Temporary parking permit application

Eligibility Criteria

- Residential parking permits will not be issued to properties subdivided after **31st August 2011**.
- Residential properties with a crossover are only eligible for one residential parking permit, regardless of whether there is a driveway.
- A residential permit is only valid while the resident resides at the address shown on the approved application form and will only be issued to properties that have parking restrictions in their street.
- A maximum of 2 residential parking permits and one MITS transition permit will be issued to a residence. The permit/s are transferable between vehicles.
- Residents living in a corner property can nominate either their front or side street. If two permits are required, both will be issued to the same street.
- Residential parking permits will only be issued for use in an applicable vehicle. This excludes a boat, bus, trailer, truck, caravan, motorcycle or vehicles greater than 4.5 tonnes or 12 metres in length.
- Residential parking permits do **NOT** guarantee parking will be available.

Permit Conditions

- The parking permit **MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED** on the inside, lower left-hand corner of the front windscreen.
- A parking permit not displayed as described above is invalid and any infringement notices issued for not displaying a valid permit will not be withdrawn.
- A statutory declaration is required for replacement permits. An administration fee is charged for replacement permits.
- A free replacement permit will be issued if the applicant's car is stolen and a copy of the police report is produced.
- Permits are not valid in areas with restrictions of 30 minutes or less.
- Permits are not valid in No Stopping, No Parking, Clearway, bus, taxi or Loading Zones or any other red signed area.
- An expired permit is not considered a valid permit and any infringement notices issued for not displaying a valid permit will not be withdrawn.
- Photocopied or misuse of permits will result in the permit being cancelled. No replacement or refund will be provided.

- In addition to the above conditions, the visitor permit must be clearly displayed on the inside, lower left-hand corner of the front windscreen with the day, date and month erased.
