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## DESIGN STATEMENT

Placement of furniture in open space areas requires minimum acceptable distances between furniture and fixtures to allow for a comfortable degree of circulation space and encourage their usage for separate groups of users with differing abilities. Providing sufficient offsets between furniture also allows maintenance crews enough access to undertake ongoing maintenance tasks without difficulty.

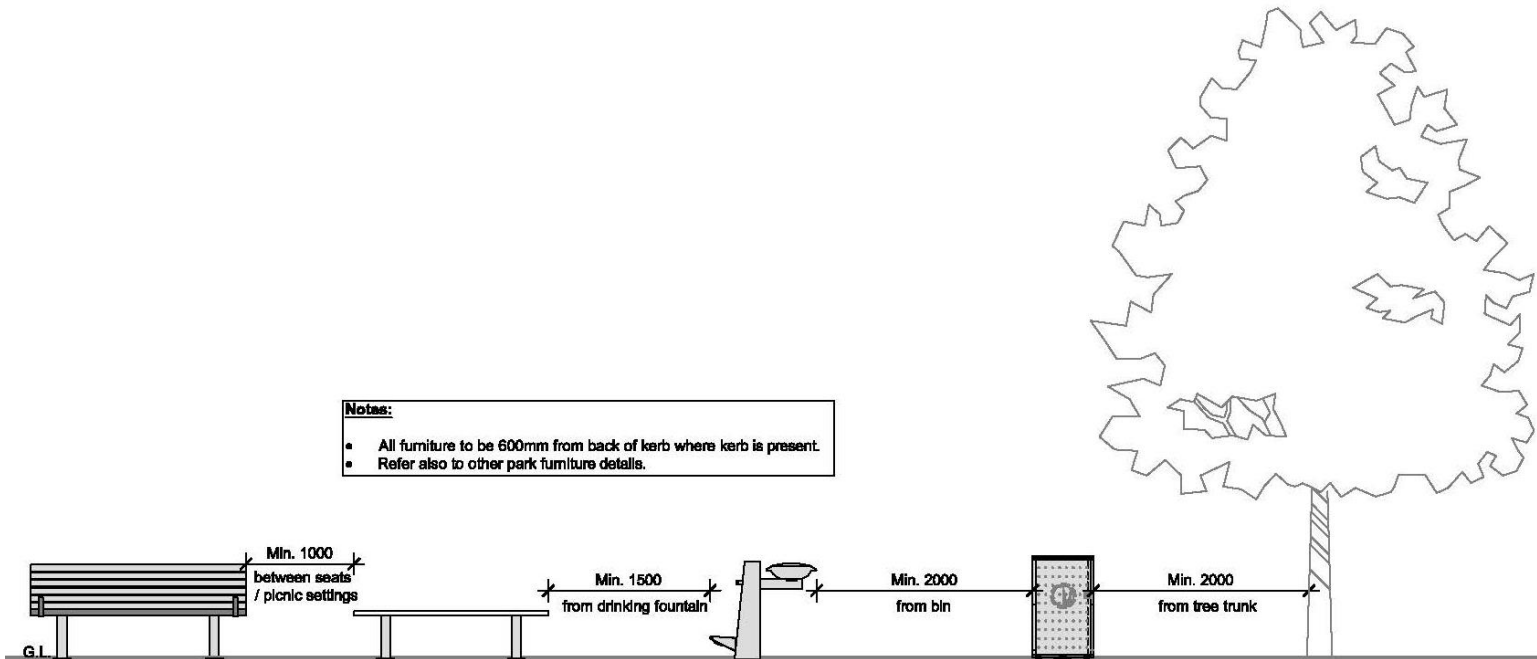
